

# **TEMPORARY PROTOCOLS & RULES FOR ROSEWOOD GOLF CLUB & COURSE DURING COVID-19 HEALTH CRISIS** (Updated 15.8.20)

*REMEMBER IF YOU OR ANYONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD IS EXPERIENCING FLU LIKE SYMPTOMS, PLEASE STAY AT HOME*

## **CLUBHOUSE**

- **ALCOHOL** is now permitted to be sold for consumption on the Course.
- Patrons must be seated when drinking & dining in Clubhouse and must comply with number limits, social distancing etc. You are required to supply your contact details & observe all staff directions.
- Bathrooms (entry via ramp preferably): Toilets are sanitised & wiped down prior to commencement each day & as required throughout the day.
- Card payments with Tap and Go are preferable, however cash will be accepted.

## **MOTORISED CARTS**

Two persons are again permitted to share Golf Cart. No requirement to be from same household.

- **CARTS** are sanitised each day (steering wheel and dashboard) when they are put out and also when they are put away. It is the responsibility of the individual to also sanitise the cart themselves (as an added guarantee) prior to and after use. Players are expected to carry their own method of sanitising, antibacterial wipes etc. (However, the Club will also have some available for this purpose).

## **COURSE**

- **ALCOHOL** is now permitted to be purchased from Club for consumption on the Course. (No BYO)
- 4 players are once again permitted in a group.
- Flagsticks may be removed (if desired) on green however players are encouraged to use gloved hand or towel when removing these.
- Bunkers are in play with preferred lie in bunkers. Players are to smooth out sand with foot on exiting bunker. (Rakes not currently in use)
- Keep a distance of 1.5 metres from one another at all times.
- Pin Shots (Competition only) have resumed.
- Scorecards: Players may swap cards for marking if they are comfortable in doing so. Otherwise, please continue to score your own score and your partners on your card and then print your partners name at the Marker's Section on the Card (verbally check details for accuracy).
- After a round, you may go into clubhouse to have a drink or snack etc, however you must obey staff directions with regard to seated dining/drinking in designated areas. (Number restrictions apply). Be prepared to provide your contact details to staff also.
- Congregating is discouraged before or after a round. Hand your card in and leave after your game if you are not attending the clubhouse to have drinks or to dine.
